Certification

Students who pursue the 'A' Level programme at VFCSS will attain the CXC CAPE (Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Exam) Certificate and can simultaneously attain the CXC Diploma or Associate Degree.

Students must study and pass a prescribed cluster of ten (10) units of the CAPE syllabus, the equivalent of seven CAPE subjects, including Caribbean Studies, Communication Studies, and Integrated Math.
